Practical information

<i>French courses</i>	The department of French as a Foreign Language (DEFLE Département d'Etude du Français Langue Étrangère) offers courses for non-native French speakers. The courses available will depend on the field of study where the student has been nominated.
<i>Housing</i>	There is a number of rooms in student halls available for incoming students. The students will have to fill in an online application in May and they will know in June/July if their application has been accepted (according to availability).
<i>Health and Medical insurance</i>	If the student is European, no needs to be register at the "Sécurité Sociale" (European Health Insurance Card), non-European students have to be registered at the "Sécurité Sociale" (free and online).
<i>Visa and immigration</i>	It is the students' responsibility to get informed and apply for a visa at the French embassy of their home country
<i>Cost of living</i>	Budget for a student in France is around 750€ per months (housing, transport, food, outing...)
